1. **Awareness Activities**

ii. **Inclusion of Anti Corruption Theme in curriculum**

- Officers of A&P Division attended a meeting convened by Ministry of Federal of Education and Professional Training on the subject on 20<sup>th</sup> June 2017. The meeting was held to discuss the draft document prepared by the Ministry for integrating cross cutting themes in the curriculum. During the discussion it was pointed out by the Additional Director (A&P) that an additional point may be added on how to rid society of corruption in Secondary Level grades. The Chair, Rafique Tahir (Joint Education Advisor), Miss Nighat Lone (Consultant) agreed and ensured the same would be included. The consultant appraised that subject curriculum for grade 1-5 has been completed, grade 6 – 8 will be initiated in July 2017 and grade 9 – 12 December 2017 onwards. iii. **NAB Theme Song – 2017**

- A meeting was held on 21<sup>st</sup> June, 2017 at 1100 Hours, at Conference Room of NAB HQ Islamabad chaired by worthy Deputy Chairman NAB (president of the Committee) for selection of best theme song for the year 2017 received from all Regional Bureaus. It has been desired by the President of the Committee to obtain the latest Theme Song – 2017 CDs through covering letter after re-edited. All Regional Bureaus are being requested to forward their NAB Them Songs by 15<sup>th</sup> July, 2017 with the instructions that if no response received by the target date, the region will be considered out of competition.

iv. **Preparation of NAB's Newsletter**

- A&P Division is preparing 5<sup>th</sup> issue of NABs Newsletter for the period of 1<sup>st</sup> January, 2017 to 30<sup>th</sup> June, 2017. A&P Division has started following tasks:-

v. **Coordination with:**

- Ministry of Industries and Production forwarded the NAB's proposals to All Pakistan Cement Manufacturers Associations (APCMA) with the request to consider the proposal for implementation. In this regard follow up have been made with the association.
- Mr. Zafar Abbas Jafri, Director Public Affairs Coke-Cola with the request to join the war against corruption and spread the message of "Enjoy Coca-Cola and Say No to Corruption" or "Say No to Corruption and Yes to Coca-Cola" by printing the same on bottles, cans etc.
- Mr. Kamran Ali Chief Regulatory Affairs CM Pak (Zong) with the request that Mobile Phone is the best source to convey / spread the anti-corruption message "Say No to Corruption" to the masses across the country. It is therefore, requested that following

i **Complaint regarding Corruption/ Mis-procurement in Pakistan Post Office Department**

Subsequent to the briefing given by the Officials of Pakistan Post Office on May 19, 2017 and analysis of the documents submitted by Pakistan Post Office an advisory letter was sent to Pakistan Post Office advising them to adhere strictly with PPRA rules and refrain from verbally correcting typographical errors in tender documents
