The monthly progress report for the month of May, 2017 is submitted as under please:-

1. **Awareness Activities**

a. **Spreading the message Say No to Corruption through Daewoo Bus Service**

- NAB had requested the Daewoo Express Bus Service to join hands with NAB and spread the message Say No to Corruption.
- Additional Director (A&P) has continuously coordinated with GM (Operation) for implementation of NAB proposals.
- In response, GM (Operations) sent a CD and telephonically informed that the following arrangements have been made:-
 - a) Banners have been displayed outside the Daewoo Building situated at Faisalabad, Karachi, Lahore, Multan, Peshawar and Rawalpindi.
 - b) Standees with the message "Say No to Corruption" have been displayed in waiting halls and ticket counters of Daewoo Terminals at Abbotabad, Bahawalpur, Chowk Bahauder, Dera Ghazi Khan, Dera Ismail Khan, Faisalabad, Hyderabad, Karachi, Lahore Multan, Peshawar, Rawalpindi, Sargodha and Sialkot.
 - c) NAB Theme Song video "Say No to Corruption" is being played in all Daewoo Buses
 - d) NAB Theme Song video "Say No to Corruption" is also being played in waiting halls situated at Rawalpindi and Lahore terminals after 5 to 10 minutes continuously.

b. **Spreading the message Say No to Corruption through Punjab Metro Bus Authority**

- NAB had asked Punjab Metro Bus Authority to join hands with NAB to spread the message "Say No to Corruption". Additional Director (A&P)

has coordinated with Managing Director and GM (Operations) Punjab Metro Bus Authority, they informed that Banners with “Say No to Corruption” are being displayed on all Metro Stations from Saddar Rawalpindi to Secretariat Islamabad.

c. **Spreading the message Say No to Corruption by writing on Cement Bags and displaying of Banners**

- After getting approval from competent authority, a proposal was forwarded to Secretary, Ministry of Industries and Production for spreading the slogan “Say No to Corruption” by writing on Cement Bags and also displaying banners carrying the message “Say No to Corruption” on main entrance of Cement Factories operating in Pakistan.
- Ministry of Industries and Production forwarded the NAB’s proposals to All Pakistan Cement Manufacturers Associations (APCMA) with the request to consider the proposal for implementation.

d. **Coordination with:**

- i. Mr. Zafar Abbas Jafri, Director Public Affairs Coke-Cola with the request to join the war against corruption and spread the message of “Enjoy Coca-Cola and Say No to Corruption” or “Say No to Corruption and Yes to Coca-Cola” by printing the same on bottles, cans etc.
- ii. Mr. Kamran Ali Chief Regulatory Affairs CM Pak (Zong) with the request that Mobile Phone is the best source to convey / spread the anti-corruption message “Say No to Corruption” to the masses across the country. e. **Lectures:**

- ii. Additional Director A&P also gave lecture at Pakistan Manpower Institute (PMI) on “The Role of NAB in Awareness and Prevention of Corruption” on 17th May, 2017.

f. **Seminar / Workshop**

- a. In continuation of MOU, HEC has issued instructions to all Universities under its jurisdiction to carry out different activities to raise awareness against corruption.

In this context, Fatima Jinnah Women University holds a seminar on “*Say No To Corruption*” organized by Student Affairs Office on **12th May, 2017**. The main aim of seminar is awareness and prevention to involve all segments of society, especially women and children, in saying “**Say No To Corruption**”. **(Flag-A)**

- b. A workshop on the role of NAB in public procurement was organized by Transparency International Pakistan in collaboration with United States Agency for International Development and the office of the Inspector General (OIG) on **18th May, 2017** at Islamabad. NAB participation was required to know how instrumental and vital NAB’s role in ensuring that transparency and accountability prevails in public procurement.

The Competent Authority has nominated DG (Ops) to attend the said workshop. A&P Division has prepared a detailed presentation for the workshop. Additional Director A&P has also attended the workshop alongwith DG (Ops). **(Flag-B)**

h. **Inclusion of Anti Corruption Theme in Curriculum**

- A&P Division has been in continuous follow up with Ms. Nighat Lone Consultant GIZ for inclusion of “Anti-Corruption Theme” in Curriculum at all levels. She informed that the draft of the revised curriculum for Class I-V will be submitted to Minister for Federal Education and professional Training for his review and onward circulation to all concerned stakeholders for their comments.

2 **Prevention Committees**

i. **Prevention Committee on Capital Development Authority (CDA)**

A meeting of the subject committee was held on 4th May, 2017 at A&P Division, NAB HQ. As per directions of worthy Deputy Chairman, recommendations of Prevention Committee on Capital Development Authority has been reviewed and improved in consultation with CDA officials and the said recommendations / presentation has been submitted to Competent Authority for perusal accordingly.

ii. **Prevention Committee on the Affairs of Pakistan Sports Board**

iv. **Prevention Committee on Health, Sub-Committee - 09 on Procurement of Drugs Medicines & Medical Instruments**

- A meeting of the subject committee was held at A&P Division NAB HQ. Wherein, draft recommendations were discussed in length. During the

meeting valuable inputs were received from all committee members and have been incorporated.

- Draft recommendations along with the presentation have been submitted to Competent Authority for perusal.

v. **Prevention Committee on Press Information Department**

- The draft final recommendations of Prevention Committee on Press Information Department have been submitted for perusal / approval of Competent Authority on 19th May, 2017.
- However, the same has been pended till further orders.

3. **General Complaints**

i. **Complaint Against Non-Registered Accounting Bodies**

- The Ministry of Federal Education & Professional Training was earlier requested to take appropriate action and to devise way forward, as the existence of such unaccredited accounting bodies may pose threat to the future of the students who are associated with them. The Ministry has now forwarded reply of HEC through their letter. It has been informed that the Institute of Certified Public Accounts of Pakistan approached this office recognition of its certification, which has been already categorically denied on the reasons. Moreover, HEC periodically alerts the general public to seek admission only in recognized institutions available on HEC website.
- The worthy Deputy Chairman has directed to conduct a meeting at A&P Division with stake holders to resolve the issue.

ii. **Irregularities regarding stipends given to Children of Federal Government Employees**

- The comments of FEB & GIF on complaint regarding stipends given to Children of Federal Government Employees were found unsatisfactory for Category-V. On which a meeting was conducted on **23rd May, 2017 at 1430 Hours** at A&P Division, NAB HQ on the directions of Worthy Deputy Chairman.
- The official from FEB & GIF informed that the issue will be discussed in forth coming Management Committee Meeting.

iii. **Complaint regarding Corruption/ Mis-procurement in Pakistan Post Office Department**

A briefing was called in on **May 19, 2017**; officers/ officials from Pakistan Post attended this office. Matter was discussed in detail and advisory letter is under process. Pictures are attached at **Flag-C**.
