1. **Awareness Activities**

i. **Colouring Book**

- NAB in collaboration with National College of Arts Lahore prepared Colouring Book for the secondary level students. The said Colouring Book was inaugurated by the Honourable President Islamic Republic of Pakistan during the seminar on the eve of International Anti-Corruption Day 9th December, 2016. - DG (A&P) is making efforts for sponsorship of two thousand colouring books. In this context, a letter has been sent to Mr. Yasuhiro TOJO, Chief Representative Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA) for sponsorship of 2000 x Colouring Books for the Secondary Level Students.

viii. **Coordination with:**

DG (A&P) pursued the matter and the message “Say NO to Corruption” was sent to all subscribers all over the country.

2. **Prevention Activities**

a) **Progress of Prevention Committees**

i. **Prevention Committee on Pakistan Railways**

In Continuation to the meeting held on 10th November, 2016, second meeting was scheduled on 15th December, 2016. However on the request of management of Pakistan Railways, the meeting was rescheduled on 4th January, 2017.

ii. **Prevention Committee on Capital Development Authority (CDA)**

2 x meetings of Prevention Committee on Capital Development Authority (CDA) were held in December 2016 for reviewing final presentation / recommendations as per the directions of Deputy Chairman NAB. The recommendations are finalized and being submitted for perusal of Competent Authority.

b) **General Complaints**

Complaint against CDA officials regarding delay in giving possession in Sector I-15 Sector, Islamabad

Meeting was held with CDA officials on 14th December, 2016 for preparation of an activity chart specifying the time lines for the initiation of sector development work. However CDA official have shown their inability of activity chart before completion of the following activities:-

- 1) Resolution of Consultant's payment / work claims
- 2) Revision of PC-1
- 3) Preparation of bidding documents
- 4) NIT (Notice inviting tender) tender advertisement for sector development (I-15)
- 5) Bid Evaluation
- 6) Award of contract for sector development (I-15)

c) **Pension Systems and Problems:**

On the directions of the Deputy Chairman, SOP's for pension system were developed for timely pension disbursement aiming to reduce the hardship of pensioners. These SOPs were submitted to the Deputy Chairman for perusal.

d) **Brief for Minster of Law and Justice**

A&P Division has prepared a report on eradication of Corruption from Federal Government Department and forwarded to Ministry of Law and Justice. On the request of Ministry of Law and Justice, a brief on the report was also prepared by A&P Division for Minister of Law and Justice.

e) **Report / Recommendations on the Observations of Sub-Committee of Public Accounts Committee of National Assembly of Pakistan**

- The Operations Division NAB had forwarded the observations of PAC Sub Committee to A&P Division with the request to re-visit the policy in the light of these observations.
- A&P Division thoroughly examined the policy in the light of terms and condition contained in the Brochure issued by Federal Government Employees Housing Foundation for Federal Government Employees, Islamabad Housing Scheme Phase-IV.

- After reviewing the policy, A&P Division prepared recommendations and submitted to competent Authority as desired.

f) **Archiving of Contracts**

- A total of 520 contracts were digitalized and archived in the year 2016 (Oct-Dec), out of which 28 contracts were completed in the month of December, 2016.
- Initially the mandate of digitalization and archiving was from 2005 to 2010, which were to be completed within January 2017. However these contracts were completed in the 1st week of December 2016.
- A&P Division is aiming to conclude the remaining year 2013 to 2016 within the 1st quarter of 2017.
