The monthly progress report for the month of November, 2016 is submitted as under please:

1. **Awareness Activities**

i. **Colouring Book**

- A colouring book “Say NO to Corruption” for Secondary level has been prepared in collaboration with National College of Arts, Lahore to create awareness against corruption in students. The secondary level colouring book will be inaugurated by the President of Pakistan on the eve of International Anti Corruption Day (9th Dec, 2016)
- This book uniquely examines the factors that contribute to various forms of corruption and will go a long way in changing the mindset of our future generation towards corruption.
- The main purpose behind producing these colouring books is to sensitize the youth of our country against ill effects of corruption. The need of the hour is that children begin to despise the act of corruption from childhood.
- DG (A&P) has a meeting with Principal NCA on 11th Nov, 2016, about finalization of sketches in the light of Deputy Chairman’s instructions and asked to share the colouring book with NAB after amendments.
- DG (A&P) presented the final sketches of colouring book to the Chairman NAB’s. The Chairman accorded approval and the final colouring book (hard and soft copy) handed over to Admn Wing for printing of 100 books to be launched in the Seminar on International Anti Corruption Day held on Dec 09, 2016. The message “Say No to Corruption” has become a trademark of anti-corruption campaigns therefore it is proposed that the said message may be displayed on screens in waiting halls and on ticketing booth at Railway station.

2. **Prevention Activities**

a) **Progress of Prevention Committees**

i. **Prevention Committee on Cooperatives Department, Islamabad Capital Territory (ICT)**

The recommendations of the Subject committee have been finalized and disseminated to the Ministry of Interior for implementation.

ii. **Prevention Committee on Pakistan Railways**

In pursuance of National Accountability Bureau's letter dated **25th October, 2016**, First meeting of the subject Prevention Committee was held on **10th November, 2016 at NAB HQ**, which was presided by Deputy Chairman NAB / President Prevention Committee.

Deputy Chairman highlighted the importance of Pakistan Railways and desired to bring transparency, improvement and professionalism through reformation in Pakistan Railways.

DG (A&P) made a presentation to highlight the composition, mandate of the subject Prevention Committee. DG (Ops) and A / DG NAB Rawalpindi also made a brief account of the cases related to Pakistan Railways handled by NAB at enforcement stage.

DG Technical Pakistan Railways briefed about the procurement, land and asset management system of Pakistan Railways. Next meeting will be held on **15th December 2016** and management of Pakistan Railways will make a detailed presentation.

iii. **Prevention Committee on Capital Development Authority (CDA)**

The review of the recommendations of subject committee, as per the directions is under process. The concerned officers of CDA are out of country and work will be finalized after their return, in the next month.

b) **General Complaints**

1) **Complaint against CDA Officials regarding delay in giving possession of Sector I-15, Islamabad**

A meeting was held on 15th Nov 2016, at (A & P) Division NAB HQ, Islamabad to get updated status on the progress of the development of

sector I -15. The issues hampering the development were discussed at length and it was suggested that a high level committee headed by a Member (CDA) comprising of officers from Quantity Surveyor Directorate (QSD), Engineering Wing, Planning, & Design Wing and Finance Wing (CDA) may be constituted by Chairman CDA to assess the rendered/ claimed services and resolution of the issues of the M/S Designmen (Consultant) within a one month's time.

As per directions, meeting has been planned with CDA officials for obtaining an activity chart along with time lines for the development of Sector I-15.

2) **Violation of PPRA and CCP Act 2010 in Various Motorway Projects-NHA**

A complaint was received in this Division wherein it has been alleged that the award of contract for construction / operation of fuel stations and allied facilities in the designated service areas along the under construction motorways i.e. M-9 (Karachi- Hyderabad Motorway) and M-8 (Gawadar-Turbat-Hoshab) Motorways are being handed over to HASCOL Private Limited, at heavily subsidized rentals by the contractor FWO without open competitive bidding, in violation of procurement rules.

Comments are being sought from the procuring department on the allegation and the file is under process for approval.
