1. **Awareness Activities**

i. **Presentation**

2. **Prevention Activities**

a) **Progress of Prevention Committees**

i. **Prevention Committee on Cooperatives Department, Islamabad Capital Territory (ICT)**

A meeting of the Prevention Committee on Cooperative Department, Islamabad Capital Territory (ICT) was held under the chairmanship of Worthy Chairman NAB, on 18th October, 2016 at NAB HQ, Islamabad. The purpose of the meeting was to review the recommendations prepared by the subject Prevention Committee.

DG (A&P) presented the draft recommendations, prepared by the Committee. The Chair sought the views/input of all the Committee members in order to discuss the viability of each and every proposal in regulating the working of the housing societies.

It was decided that changes proposed in the current meeting will be incorporated in the final recommendations and thereafter the recommendations will be forwarded to all relevant government offices for implementation.

ii. **Prevention Committee on Capital Development Authority (CDA)**

A meeting of the Prevention Committee on Capital Development Authority (CDA) was held on 25th October 2016 under the chairmanship of Deputy Chairman NAB.

DG (A&P) presented the draft recommendations, prepared by the Committee. The Deputy Chairman asked the committee members to review the draft recommendations in light of court orders related to the agenda items of the subject Prevention Committee. The draft recommendations are being analyzed and amended draft is being worked on by the Committee members. 2x lower tier meetings have been held since 25th October, 2016.

iii. **Meeting of Prevention Committee on Health Sub-Committee No. 09 on Procurement of Drugs Medicines and Medical Instruments Devices.**

In pursuance of National Accountability Bureau's letter dated **5th October, 2016**, a meeting of the subject committee was held on **20th October, 2016 at 1100 hours at A&P Division NAB HQ** under the chairmanship of worthy DG (A&P) / President Prevention Committee. The salient decisions made out in the meeting are given as under:-

Dr. A.Q. Javed Iqbal, emphasized that NAB should take up the matter with Provincial Governments as well and may write to Provincial Secretaries Health to nominate a focal person preferably DG (Procurement) to participate in the committee, so that scope of committee will be broadened according to its importance. In this regard Dr. A.Q. Javed Iqbal, Convener of committee was requested telephonally to provide content / particulars of individuals on 4th November, 2016. However, response is awaited.

Composition of committee members also came under discussion during meeting. Dr. Minhaj-us-Siraj, Deputy DG from CADD, Representatives from DRAP, PIMS, DHQ Hospital Rawalpindi and Polyclinic were also present. Dr. A.Q Javed Iqbal insisted that these members may continue till the end of proceeding.

Dr. Badr-us-Samad informed about the recent procurement at PIMS for Pathology, whereby 247 items were tendered and out of this 122 items were finalized and awarded to lowest bidders as PPRA Rules. He also informed that same information was shared at PPRA website.

The Convener of Committee Dr. A.Q. Javed Iqbal said that in a country like Pakistan only 0.49% of total budget is being spent on health services whereby about 0.19% goes to corruption. Being Government servants and citizens of this country, it is our responsibility to discharge our duties in an efficient manner and fulfill our obligations / commitments of what is being desired by the platform of this prevention committee.

The next meeting of Prevention Committee is scheduled to be held in **3rd week of November 2016** whereby participants / members will present their final recommendations before committee. Pictures are at attached at **(Flag-C)**.

b) **General Complaints**

i. **Complaint against management of university scam and 5.0 Million Dollars Fraud by OGDCL, HEC, Quaid-e-Azam University and UET Taxila**

As per directions of the Deputy Chairman, HEC has been requested again in writing, to expedite its efforts for raising awareness amongst students/ parents in order to functioning of avoid illegal universities.

ii. **Probe in LNG project of SNGPL Horizontal Directional Drilling (HDD) Work**

The complainant, after repeated requests, forwarded an email quotation of Chinese Company "Dezhou Shengli Pipeline Crossing Engineering Co., Ltd" for 36" and 42" pipeline HDD works. Expert (JE-II) opined that the quotation provided via email, could not be treated as substantial evidence as it lacked authenticity and credibility.

The complaint along with the reply from SNGPL and quotation from the complainant has been forwarded to NAB Lahore for further action, if any.
