The monthly progress report for the month of September, 2016 is submitted as under please:

1. **Awareness Activities**

i. **Distribution of NAB's Newsletter**

A&P Division prepared NAB Newsletter (**Flag-A**) for the period of January – June 2016. The said period Newsletter has been distributed among different Ministries / Departments / Divisions / Regulatory Authorities of Pakistan and Regional NABs. (List attached as **Flag-B**)

ii. **Lecture by DG A&P**

DG (A&P) delivered a lecture on Say NO to Corruption in Seminar called role of future mothers / housewives in preventing corruption held at Fatima Jinnah University Rawalpindi on 29 Sept, 2016. The lecture was attended by VC, Faculty Members and large number of Students. (Pictures are attached as **Flag-C**).

iii. **SAARC Nations Seminar on Anti-Corruption**

a) **Presentation by DG (A&P) at SAARC Nations Seminar**

Director General Awareness and Prevention NAB gave a detailed presentation in the segment of Awareness (Education) and Prevention. DG (A&P) highlighted the achievements of NAB under Awareness and Prevention regime with special focus on the campaign "Say NO to Corruption".

b) **SAARC Presentation to Chairman NAB by DG (A&P)**

DG (A&P) gave presentations to Chairman and Deputy Chairman on September 01, 08 and 19, 2016 to finalize the Presentation of SAARC on Awareness and Prevention.

c) **Brochure for SAARC Nations Seminar**

Awareness and Prevention Division was tasked to prepare brochure **(Flag-D)** for the SAARC Nations Seminar. The task was completed under the guidance and Supervision of DG (A&P).

d. **Preparation of Working Paper**

The task of preparing Working Paper on the Theme of SAARC Nations Seminar was given to A&P Division. As per directions of Competent Authority, A&P Division prepared working paper and shared the same with ICW NAB HQ. Details are as under:

- i) Causes of corruption.
- ii) Ideas to reduce the prevailing situation of Corruption.
- iii) Steps to eradicate corruption.
- iv) Highlighting our role in Anti-corruption and provide an opportunity to create public awareness and commitment to curb corruption form the region.

iv. **TV Interview by DG (A&P)**

DG (A&P) gave a detailed interview in the TV programme of PTV namely "Seedhi Baat". During the Interview the efforts of NAB under Awareness & Prevention regime were highlighted. DG (A&P) emphasized that corruption is a global problem and need of the hour is to stand united internationally against corruption. DG (A&P) also highlighted the importance of SAARC Nations Seminar on Anti-Corruption.

2. **Prevention Activities**

a) **Progress of Prevention Committees**

i. **Prevention Committee on Press Information Department (PID)**

The final draft recommendations of the committee have been prepared in consultation with all members of the committee. Now the Principal Information Officer, (PIO) has been requested to recheck the draft for any changes / amendments.

ii. **Prevention Committee on Drugs Medicines and Medical Instruments Devices (Sc-9)**

Prevention Committee for Reformation of Ministry of National Health Services Regulation & Coordination (NHSR&C) and Attached / Subordinate officers was constituted by worthy Chairman NAB on **6th November, 2013**. During the first meeting of the subject Prevention Committee, 9 x Sub – Committees were constituted. Out of them 8 x Committees recommendations have already been finalized and forwarded for implementation to the concerned quarters. Sub-Committee No. 09 on ICT Hospitals was constituted for the reformation and the overall restructuring of the public sector hospitals. Number of meeting of the said committees were held in the past but due to the lack of interest of the committee members, recommendations have not been yet finalized.

For the timely disposal and finalization of the recommendation, it was decided to reconstitute and rename the committee in the light of revised subject that is “**Procurement of Drugs & Medical Devices**”. Its first meeting is scheduled on **20th October, 2016 at 1100 hrs** at A&P Division NAB HQ.

iii. **Prevention Committee on Cooperative Department, Islamabad Capital Territory (ICT)**

DD (A&P) along with Addl. Director (A&P) and Junior Expert-II (A&P) visited Registrar Cooperatives, ICT office on 27-09-2016 and slight modifications were made in a few recommendations after discussion.

The presentation of the draft final recommendations of the subject prevention committee is scheduled to be held on 18th October 2016, 1230 hours at NAB HQ.

iv. **Prevention Committee on Capital Development Authority (CDA)**

Draft final recommendations/ presentation of the subject prevention committee have been prepared and submitted for perusal.

b) **General Complaints**

i. **Complaint against CDA officials regarding delay in giving possession in Sector I-15, Islamabad**

A follow up meeting was held with the CDA officials on 08th September 2016 at (A&P) Division, NAB HQ. The issues highlighted in the previous meeting were discussed at length and thereafter CDA officials were asked to provide feedback to the proposals/ decisions discussed.

Furthermore draft reminder to Chairman CDA has also been submitted as the time frame/schedule of sector I-15 development has not been communicated yet.

ii. **Probe in LNG project of SNGPL Horizontal Directional Drilling (HDD) Work**

The complainant, after repeated requests, forwarded an email quotation of Chinese Company “Dezhou Shengli Pipeline Crossing Engineering Co., Ltd” for 36” and 42” pipeline HDD works. Expert (JE-II) opined that the quotation provided via email, could not be treated as substantial evidence as it lacked authenticity and credibility. Recommended follow up actions have been submitted.

iii. **Complaint against management of university scam and 5.0 Million Dollars Fraud by OGDCL, HEC, Quaid-e-Azam University and UET Taxila**

Subject complaint was referred by Ops Division, wherein it was recommended that “*the instant matter may be referred to A&P Division as a case study to create awareness amongst the youngsters concerning to the fact that they must verify the credentials of an institutions before applying in any discipline of higher studies*”.

Consequently, HEC was requested to share comprehensive details of all the awareness measures regarding non-recognized/ illegal institutions undertaken by HEC till date, for raising awareness among the youth of our country, with the Bureau.
