The monthly progress report for the month of August, 2017 is submitted as under please:-

1. **Awareness Activities**

i. **Incorporation of Anti-Corruption Themes in the Curriculum**

- Follow up on the status of the project was made in which it was learnt that the Minister and Secretary of Ministry of Federal Education and Professional Training have been approved the new curriculum for class I-V.
- The development of text books for class I-V has also been completed and process of advertisement to invite publishers is expected to be completed in the month of September.
- Once the task of textbooks for class I-V is completed National Curriculum Council will start work for revision of curriculum from classes VI-XII.

ii. **NAB Theme Song – 2017**

- A meeting was held on 21<sup>st</sup> June, 2017 at 1100 Hours, at Conference Room of NAB HQ Islamabad chaired by worthy Deputy Chairman NAB (president of the Committee) for selection of best theme song for the year 2017 received from all Regional Bureaus. All the songs were reviewed and the President of the Committee desired that theme song should comprise of the three prone strategy i.e. Awareness, Prevention, and Enforcement.
- In this regard, all Regional Bureaus were requested to forward their NAB theme Songs as per instructions by 15<sup>th</sup> July, 2017.
- Theme Songs have been received from all Regional NABs except NAB Rawalpindi.
- Next meeting was scheduled to be held on 30<sup>th</sup> August, 2017 however the same is being postponed as per direction of competent authority.

**For Printing / Dissemination of the message “Say No to Corruption”**

- Capt (R) Arif Nawaz Khan, Inspector General of Police (Punjab) Lahore with the request to print anti-corruption message “Say No to Corruption” on Driving Licenses in all Districts under the jurisdiction of Punjab Police. During the decision of the matter, Capt (R) Arif Nawaz Khan has shown his willingness to implement the said proposal.
- Ministry of Industries and Production forwarded the NAB’s proposals to All Pakistan Cement Manufacturers Associations (APCMA) with the request to consider the proposal for implementation. In this regard follow up have been made with the association.
- Ms. Nargis Ghaloo, Secretary Capital Administration and Development Division (CADD) with the request to display the banners / standees containing following message on key entry points of school / college. It is also requested that the said messages be written on the main gates of all schools / colleges.
- Mr. Talib Dogar, Director General Services, (PTA) with the request that Mobile Phone is the best source to convey / spread the anti-corruption message “Say No to Corruption” to the masses across the country. It is therefore requested that following messages may kindly be circulated to the mobile phone subscribers twice a month.

## **2 Prevention Committees**

### **i. Prevention Committee on Capital Development Authority (CDA)**

- Meeting of the subject committee was held on Aug 22, 2017 under chairmanship of Acting Chairman NAB. DG (A&P) gave a detailed presentation of the draft recommendations prepared by the committee.
- After threadbare discussion on the recommendations, it was decided that representatives from IESCO, SNGPL, and ICT administrations must be taken on board to get their point of view on the recommendations.

### **ii. Prevention Committee on Pakistan Sports Board**

- First meeting of the subject Prevention Committee was held on 23<sup>rd</sup> August 2017 at NAB HQ under the chairmanship of Acting Chairman NAB.
- The worthy Acting Chairman NAB advised Pakistan Sports Board and Provincial bodies to highlight the bottlenecks / issues being faced and the way forward on how to overcome such problems. We need to plan for mitigating problems through corporate sector and state patronage.
- The committee must identify the actual problems, need assessment, goals and timeline to achieve such goals. Sub-committee would be formed to speed up the working and for timely preparation of TORs.
- He further urged the members that Dubai Expo 2020 and Football World Cup 2022 must be kept in consideration while framing the TORs for the committee. (Pictures of the meeting are attached at **Flag B**)

### **iii. Prevention Committee on Health, Sub-Committee - 09 on Procurement of Drugs Medicines and Medical Instruments**

- As directed by the Deputy Chairman, and in house meeting was held in July – 2017 wherein recommendations have been further discussed with the members / convener of the committee.
- Subsequently, the updated recommendations submitted to Competent Authority for perusal. A presentation of draft recommendations of the subject Prevention Committee is scheduled to be held on 29<sup>th</sup> August, 2017. However, on the direction of Deputy Chairman NAB, meeting of the subject committee had been postponed till further orders.

iv. **Prevention Committee on Press Information Department**

- The draft recommendations of Prevention Committee on PID have been finalized and submitted for perusal / approval of Competent Authority.
- File put up to competent authority for approval of meeting on proposed recommendations may be held on 14<sup>th</sup> September, 2017 or any suitable date and time as deemed appropriate by the competent authority.

v. **Prevention Committee on Pakistan Railways**

- The nominations have been completed in the light of worthy Deputy Chairman's directions.
- Letter for convening the meeting in July, 2017 was submitted for perusal of Competent Authority. However the same will now be held on 12<sup>th</sup> September, 2017.

3. **General Complaints**

i. **Complaint regarding corruption / Mis-procurement by PMAS Arid Agriculture University.**

- A complaint was received was received the bureau regarding mis-procurement by the university in its tender for construction of new buildings. To further understand the matter and get the university 's view point on the allegations a letter was sent seeking their reply on the matter.
- After receiving reply, it was analyzed and forwarded to NAB (R) for further necessary action

ii. **Complaint against Minerals Department KPK regarding lease Agreement of Phosphates.**

- A complaint was received against Minerals Deptt KPK regarding auction of 4 x Blocks of phosphates against rules. The said complaint was referred to the Secretary Mineral Department KPK for appropriate action under4 intimation to A&P (Div) NAB HQ.

4. **Other Activities / Updates**

- Subsequent to Prime Ministers approval and due process of the standing Committee on law and Justice and Ministry of Law, Justice and Human Rights the Public Interest Disclosure Bill (Whistle Blower Protection Act) was approved from National Assembly with a majority Vote.
- Speech writing for president of Pakistan, Chairman NAB and Minister for Law and Justice on the occasion of inauguration of the new NAB HQ building.
