
SEMINARS

SEMINAR ON INTERNATIONAL ANTI-CORRUPTION DAY 2022

Seminar was arranged on International Anti-Corruption Day on 9 December 2022 at Markhor Hall, BUIITEMS University Quetta wherein 400 participants from different walks of life were present. Mr. Justice (R) Amanullah Khan Yasinzai, former Governor Balochistan and former Chief Justice Balochistan High Court, graced the occasion as chief guest. Mr. Zafar Iqbal Khan DG NAB (B), Mr. Jawad Ahmad Dogar, Addl IG and Mr. Ahmed Farooq Bazai, VC BUIITEMS University, Quetta were guest speakers of the event.



Chief Guest and Guest speakers shared their views and requested civil society and government to play their role to strengthen the laws and fill up the loopholes which cause the corruption. They emphasized on self-accountability and enforcement of Islamic value system among the masses for strengthening the moral fiber of the future generations. PROVINCIAL LEVEL COMPETITIONS – SCHOOLS



STAFF DEVELOPMENT COURSE FOR (BPS 4-7)



Corruption breeds inefficiency, destroys economy: DG NAB

Staff Report

QUETTA: Director General NAB Balochistan Zafar Iqbal Khan said that corruption bred inefficiency, "a disease that slows down economic development and creates a situation of uncertainty depriving societies of sustainable development".

He was addressing a ceremony held on Friday here at Balochistan University of Information Technology Engineering and Management Sciences to mark the International Anti-Corruption Day. Former governor of Balochistan and former chief justice of Balochistan Amanullah Yasinza, DIG Police Balochistan Jawad Ahmad Dogar, Vice Chancellor of BUITEMS Farooq Bazai and Director NAB Mohammad Rafique Memon were also present on this occasion. Addressing the participants, the NAB DG said corruption was a scourge which was damaging the very fabric of the society. If this social evil is not stopped, it will cause a huge damage to our society, he said and suggested that in order to curb the menace of corruption, a whistle-blowing system must be developed. Zafar further noted that for the stability of the country's economy and the strengthening of social values, eradication of corruption was a must. He said that the students were the real assets of the country and said that with the interest and full cooperation of the educational institutions, the various evils in the society could be eradicated.

While referring to Article 33C of the National Accountability Bureau Law, NAB has formed several committees to reform the laws that cause corruption in government departments. Director General NAB Balochistan showing annoyance over the decline of golden values said that in the past there was strong hatred prevailing against corruption, which has been forgotten with the passage of time and "it is regrettable to say that now society has accepted it". Steps on war footing are required to change this acceptance to abhorrence, he maintained.

کوئٹہ (سٹاف رپورٹر) مدرسہ البنان کے منتظم اور رویت ہلال کمیٹی کے ممبر ڈاکٹر قاری عبدالرشید نے کہا کہ بددیانتی اور بدعنوانی کے ذریعے مال جمع کرنا آخرت میں ہی نہیں بلکہ دنیا میں بھی پریشانی کا سبب ہے جس کی وجہ سے گھر میں بیماری، جھگڑے، فساد وغیرہ ہوتے ہیں۔ انہوں نے کہا کہ اس ملک میں ہمارے معاشرے کی عمارت کو بدعنوانی دیک کی طرح چاٹ رہی ہے جس کے خاتمے کیلئے عملی اقدامات ضروری ہیں۔ یہ باتیں انہوں نے مقامی بومل میں منعقدہ تقریب سے خطاب میں کہیں۔ انہوں نے کہا کہ بدعنوانی کے زمرے میں آنے والی چیزیں سرکاری اختیارات کا غلط استعمال، ناجائز مفادات کا حصول سرکار کے مالی معاملات میں خوردبرد، عوام الناس سے دھوکہ دہی، بینکوں کو مالی اداروں اور حکومتی و انتظامیاتی اداروں کی دانتہ اور آگنی ہیں۔ انہوں نے کہا کہ منصب ایک امانت ہے جب منصب قابلیت کے بغیر کسی کو دیا جائے تو اس سے بدعنوانی کا باب کھل جاتا ہے۔ کسی شخص، افراد یا قوم کا کردار اور اس کی ترقی و تیزی اور نقص کا آئینہ دار ہوتا ہے ایسا انداز مساوات، انصاف، سچ اور شفافیت کے مناروں سے کردار کی عمارت کی تعمیر و تکمیل کی جاتی ہے۔ جبکہ لالچ، جمع حرص، بددیانتی اور بدعنوانی کی اینٹیں کردار کی عمارت کو کھوکھلا بنا دیتی ہے۔ بدعنوانی کی لعنت برائیاں کی جڑ ہے اس سے عدم استحکام غربت میں اضافہ اور معاشرے کے لیے ہونے طبقات کی بدقسمتی میں اضافہ ہوتا ہے اس سے ناامیدی اور مایوسی میں اضافہ ہوتا ہے اور ایسے اقدار کے لئے خطرات پیدا ہوتے ہیں۔
